Duties and Responsibilities include:

Title: Yard Operations

- Physical overall requirements include heavy-duty work (exerting up to 100 lbs. occasionally, 50 lbs. frequently and up to 20 lbs. constantly)

- Visual acuity to operate motor vehicles and/or heavy equipment
- Ability to handle hazards such as moving vehicles, moving mechanical parts and working in high places
- Ability to handle fumes, odors, dust, gases or poor ventilation
- Ability to work indoors and outdoors (subject to cold, heat, humidity and other adverse conditions)
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) is preferred but not required
